Technical Package Update:

1) The minimum age for athletes participating in rifle sports has been changed to **16 years** of age on the day of the competition, though they must still be in possession of proper certification from the Canadian Firearms Centre (PAL, also known as FAC).

- 2) Confirmation that ammunition for rifle events will be supplied by the Labrador Winter Games for the <u>events of the game only</u>. Practice equipment for communities must be supplied by athletes themselves. The type of ammunition used this year is **Remington Golden Bullet 21276** (40 grain).
