

FAIR PLAY CODE FOR ATHLETES

1. I will participate because I want to.
2. I will play by the rules, and in the spirit of the Game.
3. I will control my temper - "fighting and mouthing off" can spoil the activity for everybody.
4. I will respect my opponents, team mates, officials, volunteers and spectators.
5. I will do my best to be a true Team Player.
6. I will remember that winning isn't everything - that having fun, improving skills, making friends and doing my best are also important.
7. I will acknowledge all good plays / performances - those of my team and of my opponent.
8. I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me. I will accept their decisions and show them respect.

FAIR PLAY CODE FOR CO-ORDINATORS

- a. I will be reasonable when scheduling team practices and training sessions remembering that participants have other interests and obligations.
- b. I will teach my athletes to play fairly and respect the rules, the officials and opponents.
- c. I will ensure that ALL athletes get equal support and playing time.
- d. I will not ridicule or yell at my athletes for making mistakes or for performing poorly.
- e. I will make sure that equipment and facilities are safe and match the athlete's age and abilities.
- f. I will remember that the younger athletes need a coordinator they can respect. I will be generous with praise and set a good example.
- g. I will ensure my athletes receive proper training and attempt to have qualified coaches working with my team.
- h. I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me. I will accept their decisions and show them respect.
